Supplies needed for the Class:

- **Short 2 foot leather leash approximately 1/4 inch in width (J and J dog supplies)**
- **Lots of high value small yummy soft TREATS (ie mozzarella string cheese, Bil Jac Natural Balance, Red Barn, thinly sliced Microwaved hot dogs until leathery, etc.) cut into small pieces the size of your ring finger nail.**
- **2 wooden Dowels – approx. 4 feet long and 1/4-1/2 inch thick (diameter). You can get them at Home Depot**
- **23 or 26 foot Flexi Lead- J and J Dog supplies**
- **6 foot leash**
- **Tug of war toys/toys that fit into your coat pocket that your dog likes**
- **Martingale or Buckle collar (no choke chains)**
